Travel information:

We are currently scheduled for departure from Long Beach at 3pm, Friday, September 14th.

As many now know the chartered boat has been changed. **WE ARE NOT TRAVELING WITH HARBOR BREEZE CRUISES.**

We will be traveling via Catalina Classic Cruises, departing from Queen Mary Landing. I suggest arriving no later than 2pm for our 3pm departure. This will allow enough time for staging the luggage and kids for boarding. Parking will be \$20 per night. There will be a snack bar on the boat, as well as at camp. Bring cash. Please take a moment to review the departure times, directions and luggage guidelines.

Departure: Queen Mary Landing, Long Beach, on Friday, September 14th, 3pm. Travel time is about 2 hours, arriving at about 5pm.

Departure: Emerald Bay Camp dock, on Sunday, September 16th, 10am. Travel time is about 2 hours, arriving at about 12pm.

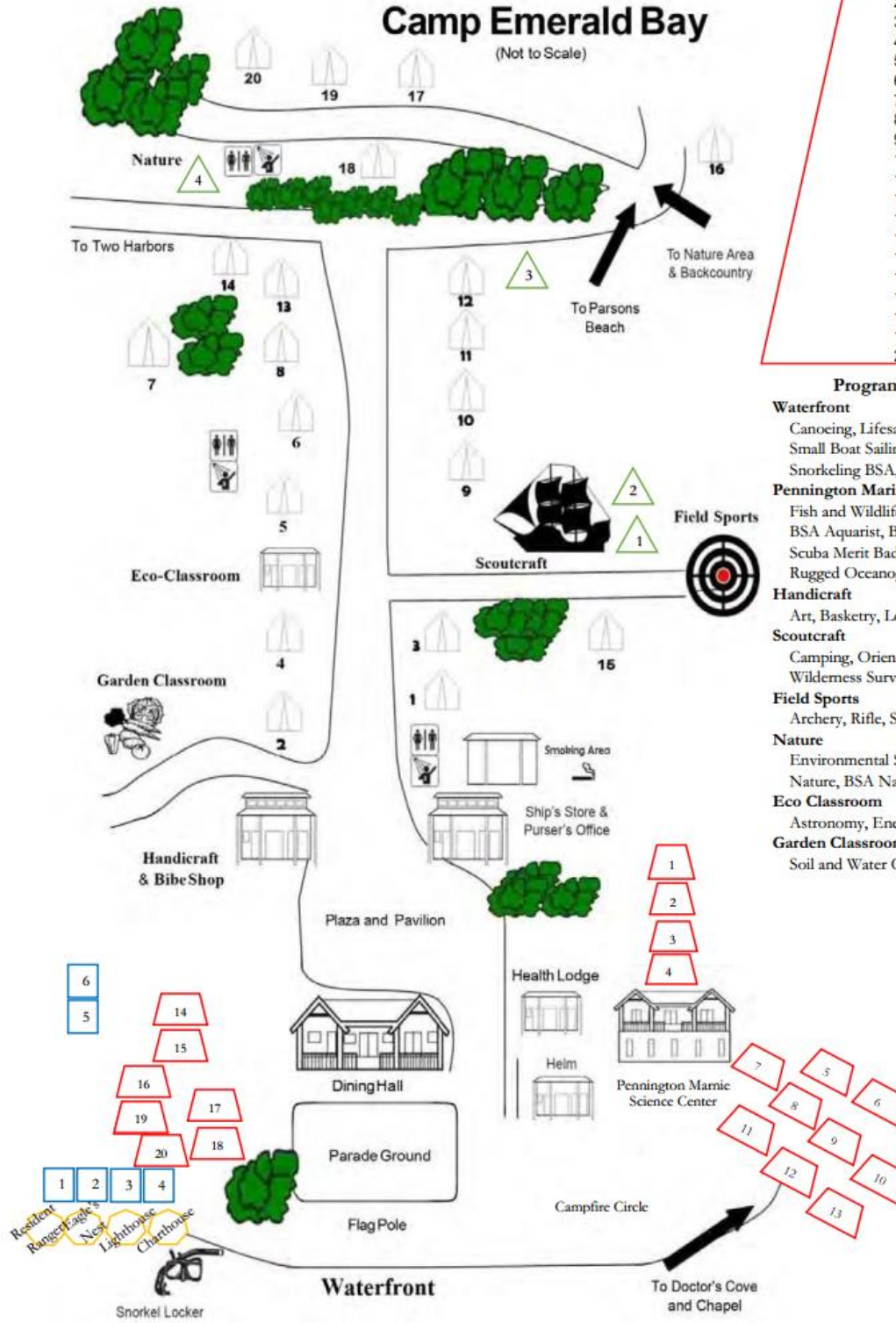
