Cabin and Tent Camping:

- Cabins \$87/person
- Tents \$52/person (Limited to locations around cabins with a majority in the back meadows, an approximately 10 to 15 minute walk.)

Activities:

- **INDUCTION CEREMONY:** For all OSN members new since last year's Lazy W Induction! This will be a great memory to share with your daughter.
- **CAMP SCHEDULED EVENTS:** Facilitated by the Lazy W Ranch staff.
 - Archery
 - Sasquatch Hunting Training (New Team Building Event)
- **CHIEF KODA:** Hoping for an appearance by OSN's Great Spirit mentor!
- **7TH ANNUAL NATURE SCAVENGER HUNT:** Collect every item on the checklist. Then have your Princess present her collection to the Eagle Eyes host tribe to receive the new 2018 Scavenger Hunt patch.
- **OTHER CAMP OFFERINGS:** GaGa pit, tetherball, beach volleyball, basketball, and ping pong.
- **DAUGHTERS DONATE:** Collecting gently used books.



Details:

Camp Fires: Dependent on **FIRE DANGER LEVEL**. If there is Red Flag fire warning **NO CAMP FIRES OF ANY KIND WILL BE PERMITTED**. Otherwise, no open fires except that tribes can bring portable "raised" fire pits for use in acceptable areas away from any cabins/trees/grass. All coals must be doused before departure and disposed of in camp provided Ash Cans. Lazy W provides limited firewood – Tribes bring your own wood to be safe.

NO Scenic Hiking/Walks: Due to the Holy Fire this summer, all hiking trails have been **CLOSED** by the Forestry Service. If found hiking, the Forestry Service can issue a \$5,000/person ticket!

Meals:

- **Optional** Friday dinner provided by the Camp (\$11/person) from 5:30 PM to 7:00 PM. If interested Sign-up on CircleBridge.
- Tribes bring their own cooking equipment and cook own food, except Saturday Breakfast.
- Saturday morning **Nation Pancake Breakfast** at the Chuck House hosted by the Phoenix.

What to Bring: Cool weather clothes for evening. Warm weather clothes for daytime. Sleeping bag, pillow, towels, snacks, toiletries, water bottle, walking/hiking shoes, sunscreen, hat, medicine, bug spray, sunglasses, flashlights, chairs, camera, and firewood. Plus TENT, if tenting.

Arrival/Departure Times: Earliest arrival 4pm Friday, November 9th. Depart by 2pm Sunday.



Directions:

Take I-5 South. Exit at Ortega Highway 74 and turn left. Go about 12.5 miles and turn left onto Hot Spring Canyon Road (Lazy W sign is posted at the turn). You will drive about 1.5 miles down a restricted usage road.

Garmin GPS is known to get this wrong, FYI. There is **NO** cell signal at the camp.



2. Take the CA-74/Ortega Hwy exit toward San Juan Capistrano 0.2 mi

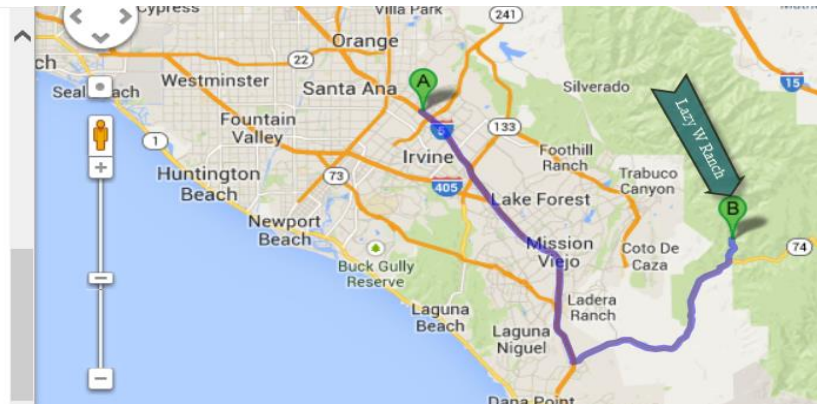
3. Turn left onto CA-74 E/Ortega Hwy 12.5 mi

4. Turn left onto Hot Spring Canyon Rd 1.4 mi

5. Slight right to stay on Hot Spring Canyon Rd
Restricted usage road
Destination will be on the right 0.2 mi
