

Lazy W Ranch Campout!

Schedule of Events – Nov. 9-11, 2018



FRIDAY

- 4:00 pm Arrival and setup – Campers will not be allowed to enter before 4pm, but arrive as early as you can as it gets dark early! Camp waivers are due to your chief.
- 5:30 – 7:30 Dinner hosted by Lazy W staff at Dining Hall (pre-paid only).

SATURDAY

- 8:00 – 9:00 Pancake Breakfast (hosted by the Phoenix at the Chuck House). Sign-ups for Archery. Drop off *Daughters Donate* books.
- 8:30 – 8:45 Camp Orientation at Chuck House (ALL ATTENDEES).
- 9:00 – 1:00 Archery (See Tribe Activity Schedule, see below).
- 9:30 – Lunch Scavenger Hunt – pickup supplies from Eagle Eyes (near Cabin 10). Open time for gaga, horseshoes, stand up Jenga, giant checkers, connect 4, ping pong, volleyball, basketball, hiking.
- Lunchtime Lunch with your tribe.
- 1:30 – 2:15 Sasquatch Hunting Training (Session 1, See Tribe Activity Schedule below) – meet on the steps near the volleyball court.
- 2:00 – 2:15 Recital of Six Aims – for those who want to earn their Six Aims patch. Meet the Nation Chief by the Dining Hall.
- 2:30 – 3:15 Sasquatch Hunting Training (Session 2, See Tribe Activity Schedule below) – meet on the steps near the volleyball court.
- 3:15 – 5:00 Dinner prep for some, free time for others. Archery closed, everything else open.
- 5:00 – 5:45 Dinner with your tribe (make sure inductees eat first).
- 5:45 – 7:00 Induction! Meet in front of the main Hall then our Chiefs will lead everyone up to the fire ring area.
- 7:00 – 8:30 Nation Campfire (keep a look out for Koda!).

SUNDAY

- 8:30 - 9:00 Roundup (in the Fire Circle).
- 10:00am Clean up your campsites! Leave it better than you found it!
- 12:00pm Check Out. Cabins need to be vacated and swept.

Notes and Rules:

- Orange Spirit Nation and Lazy W Ranch have a zero tolerance alcohol policy.
- Carpooling is **HIGHLY RECOMMENDED**. Park in designated parking areas only. If you need to pull up to your cabin to drop off your equipment, be respectful of others and please move your car quickly. Space must be left to permit Lazy W staff or emergency vehicles to pass in all areas.
- In the event of a red flag warning, no wood burning campfires are allowed. Propane fire pits are ok. Each campsite area will have designated cans for coals and ash. Tribes should bring their own firewood and above ground fire pits for wood burning fires.
- Trash will be picked up by the Lazy W staff. If your tribe's cans fill up before the pick-up, please tie the bag and set it next to the can to be picked up.
- The adventure tower is off limits to OSN. Appropriate signage and measures have been taken to prevent anyone from using it, as it is highly dangerous. Anyone caught trying to climb the tower will be asked to leave the premises immediately.
- Coolers are to remain outside all carpeted cabins and lodges.
- The kitchen at the main dining hall is off limits. However, Lazy W staff will provide access to the ice machine and the phone (for emergencies) at the main dining hall.
- There is no cell service at Lazy W, so be sure to tell your loved ones in advance. If needed, the phone number of the camp office is 949-728-0141.
- If you are in need of assistance please contact the Lazy W staff at the Camp Office, and ring the buzzer by the door for remote assistance if they are not in the office.
- Los Pinos Trail Head is CLOSED by the U.S. Forestry Service. A Fine may be issued if caught hiking on the trails.
- Make sure to **HAVE FUN!** and **MAKE MEMORIES WITH YOUR DAUGHTER(S)!**
