Details:

Camp Fires: To be Determined – If there is a Red Flag Warning in Effect No Fires will be permitted. If the weather cooperates, tribes can bring portable "raised" fire pits for use in acceptable areas away from any cabins/trees/grass. All coals must be doused before departure. Lazy W does provide limited firewood – Tribes bring your own wood to be safe.



Meals:

- Tribes bring their own cooking equipment and cook own food.
- Saturday morning **AWESOME, DELICIOUS AND TASTY Nation Pancake Breakfast** at the Chuck House hosted by the Phoenix! **THANK YOU PHOENIX!**
- **Friday Night Dinner by Lazy W staff available for \$11 per person.** Sign-up please.

What to Bring: Cool weather clothes for evening. Warm weather clothes for daytime. Sleeping bag, pillow, towels, snacks, toiletries, water bottle, walking/hiking shoes, sunscreen, hat, medicine, bug spray, sunglasses, flashlight, chairs, camera, firewood. Plus **TENTS**, if tenting.

Arrival/Departure Times: Earliest arrival 4pm Friday, November 8th. Depart by 2pm Sunday.

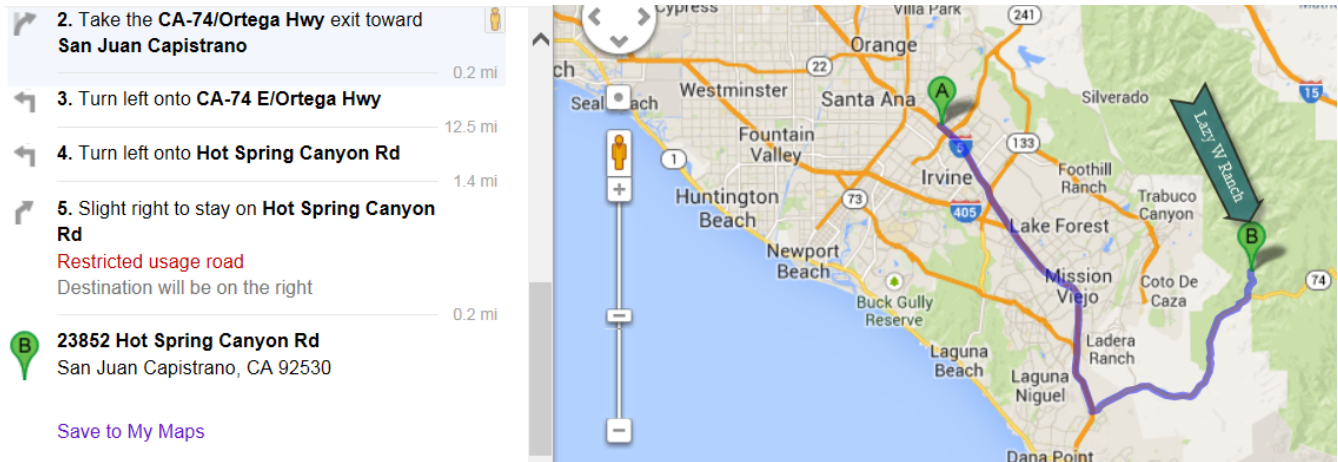


Directions:

The Lazy W Ranch is one of the most accessible camps in Southern California, only about 30 miles from the Irvine/Tustin area. Take I-5 South. Exit at Ortega Highway 74 and turn left. Go about 12.5 miles and turn left onto Hot Spring Canyon Road. You will drive about 1.5 miles down a restricted usage road.

Garmin GPS is known to get this wrong, FYI. There is no cell signal at the camp.

Note that Parking will be tight. Along with tribal cabin assignments, instructions for drop off and parking areas will be emailed about 2 days prior to camp.



Note: Lazy W Ranch has a **zero tolerance alcohol policy**. Dads and their kids may be sent home early for violations. Don't be that guy!
